MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
ON ACADEMIC COLLABORATION
BETWEEN
KYOTO PHARMACEUTICAL UNIVERSITY
AND
NATIONAL CHENG KUNG UNIVERSITY

Kyoto Pharmaceutical University and National Cheng Kung University agreed to sign the following Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) on academic collaboration in order to foster cooperation of pharmacy education and scientific research between the two institutions.


1. Within the fields that are mutually acceptable, the following general forms of cooperation are pursued:
 - 1.1 Exchange education;
 - 1.2 Visits and exchange of faculty, pharmacy students and staff for research;
 - 1.3 Joint research activities and academic conferences.
2. The terms of and the necessary resources for such joint activities and exchange programs shall be discussed and mutually agreed upon in writing by both institutes prior to the initiation of the particular activity or program.
3. The institute that hosts the exchange students shall provide the other institute with an evaluation of the students' course work at the host university upon the request of the other party. This may be recognized for academic credit at the home university according to its rules and regulations.
4. Exchange or visiting students, scholars, fellows and faculty members of both institutes are required to follow the regulations of the host institute and law of the host country.
5. Both institutes understand that all financial arrangements will have to be negotiated and will depend on the availability of funds.
6. This MOU between the two institutes shall remain in effect for a period of 5 years from the date of signing, at which time it will be reviewed for possible renewal for another 5-year period. Amendments or termination of this MOU may be made at any time through mutual consent of the two institutes.


